Program Summary:

Miami Community Ventures (MCV) is a collective impact initiative designed to connect low income "structurally unemployed" individuals to living-wage jobs. Hired participants receive wrap-around services for up to a year. These services include assistance with transportation, childcare, legal, career guidance, connections, and any other support needed to ensure they succeed in their job and developing careers.

The MCV Success Coach / Job Specialist will spearhead candidate readiness, employer cultivation, and delivery of wrap-around services for hired candidates; in an assigned target audience and geographic area.

The MCV program is based on an award-winning model run in Michigan and is open to underserved candidates throughout Miami-Dade County with an emphasis on communities having poverty rates of 20%+

- Develop and manage On-the-Job Training (OJT) agreements with businesses in the assigned
