

NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION

Pursuant to the evaluation of responses received for the above-referenced solicitation, Miami-Dade Beacon Council intends to select the following vendor:

WOT, Inc

This intended decision is based on the evaluation criteria stated in the solicitation and the agency's determination that the selected vendor's proposal is the most advantageous to the State, taking into consideration price and the other criteria set forth in the solicitation.

Any person who is adversely affected by this intended decision must file a written notice of protest with Camela Glean Jones within 72 hours after the electronic posting of this notice. Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays are excluded in the computation of the 72-hour period.

A formal written protest must be filed within 10 days after the date the notice of protest is filed. The formal written protest must state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based.

A protest bond or other security is required by law and must be filed within the time allowed for filing the bond/security. The agency will provide the estimated contract amount as required by law after receipt of a notice of protest.

Required statutory waiver statement:

"Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under chapter 120, Florida Statutes."
